Program & FM Site Director Preparations

- Throughout the autumn 2012, PSQ documents were flying back and forth between RC & FM Programs/Sites & the PGME Office.
- For FM Programs/Sites, the DFCM & PGME office were also part of the PSQ review process.
- In November 2012, 54 RC PSQs were completed & submitted for a waiver of on-site review. . .yippee!
- In December 2012, the RC Programs that have a mandated on-site review & all the FM Programs/Sites were working on completion of their PSQs.
- Until February 2013, we are (impatiently) waiting to hear which RC Programs do/do not have a waiver.
- Again, Thank you! to all the Program Directors, Site Directors, Program/Site PSQ teams, DFCM PG Office team & the PGME Office team for the extraordinary efforts to review, refine and complete high quality accreditation documents.
- Schedule templates are being distributed to all RC & FM Programs/Sites for completion & submission in January 2013.
- The Programs/Sites with mandated on-site reviews now have a *firm* date for their April 2013 review. The RC programs who may/may not have a waiver have been given 2 *firm* dates...and are drafting schedules (and holding time in their calendar and those of all faculty and residents) for those 2 days. We know waiting until February 2013 for final dates from RCPSC is not ideal.
- **NOTE:** The 'firm' date is 'usually' also the final date. . .but not always.

Important dates & timelines

- January 2013 deadlines for submission of schedule for on-site programs.
- **Double-check** your calendar and make sure that you ARE planning to attend the Sunday afternoon/evening session on April 7, 2013, which is the launch of accreditation week...this is a 'must attend' event for ALL RC & FM Program Directors and FM Site Directors.

Resident Readiness

- Remember that April 2013 is accreditation time for PGME at U of T.
- Over the past 3 years, many residents have been involved in the internal review of their program.
- Early in 2013, the Vice Dean Dr. Salvatore Spadafora and/or Associate Dean Dr. Glen Bandiera will hold
 a series of meetings with residents affiliated health facilities to orient you to the upcoming accreditation
 activities and deadlines. *Watch* for notices and come out and get caught up on PGME and accreditation
 activities.
- As accreditation week is a 'must attend' activity that occurs every 6 years, you may notice that vacation and conference requests for absence are not available for accreditation week (i.e. April 7-12). This is because the accreditors' expectation is to have an opportunity to meet with all residents.

Hospital and Facilities Hints

- Over the autumn 2012, the Hospital/Health Facility PSQs were completed, submitted and reviewed.
- In December the reviewed PSQs will be returned for refinement and completion.
- By January we anticipate we will confirm which sample of Hospitals/Health Facilities will have on-site meetings in April as well as the planned date for the meetings.
- Over the autumn 2012, Vice Dean Dr. Salvatore Spadafora and/or Associate Dean Dr. Glen Bandiera held meetings with the educational leads at the affiliated health facilities to orient them to the upcoming accreditation activities and deadlines.

Important dates & timelines for Hospitals & Facilities

January 11, 2013 is the deadline for Hospitals/Health Facilities to submit completed PSQ.

Program Administrators

- Between organizing residents and faculty, and tracking all of the versions of PSQs and attachments, the autumn has flown by for Program Administrators.
- Schedule templates are being distributed to all RC & FM Programs/Sites for completion and submission in January 2013.
- The Programs/Sites with mandated on-site reviews now have a *firm* date for their April 2013 review. The RC programs who may/may not have a waiver have been given 2 *firm* dates, and are drafting schedules (and holding time in their calendar and those of all faculty and residents) for those 2 days. We know waiting until February 2013 for final dates from RCPSC is not ideal.
- **Also**, for many Medical, Pediatric and Surgical Programs scheduled on Monday OR Tuesday...the timing of those 2 days is different.
- **NOTE:** the 'firm' date is 'usually' also the final date. . .but not always.
