### Planning for CaRMS MSM

- Historically the # of positions in match for medical subspecialties based on # of eligible PGY3s in Internal Medicine plus CMRs
- Prior to 2014, a small # of unmatched trainees did PGY4 year of Internal Medicine.
- ➢ In recent years, increasing # of trainees opting for 4<sup>th</sup> year
- Planning for envelope of positions for medical subspecialties affected by increased # PGY4s in IM and funding limitations



### Planning for MSM Match (con't)

- CaRMS MSM runs from July to November annually
- DoM responsible for allocating envelope of positions among 14 subspecialties
- Other programs in MSM include: Adult Critical Care, Pain Medicine and Palliative Medicine
- MSM match runs in two iterations in CaRMS
- PGME determines ability to participate in second iteration pending outcome of first iteration and availability of funding.


