

Call Rooms at THP

- All THP call rooms are furnished as per current PARO-CAHO agreement
 - Rooms are equipped with PC's for EMR access, have a common locker room area and small kitchen appliances (kettle, fridge)
- Call rooms are accessible via secure card access provided through the Education Office
 - Access is restricted to Residents, Medical Students and a small group of Professional Staff (who support learners)
 - Rooms are locked from the inside by occupant (signage switches from “available” to “occupied” once locked)
- Call rooms are assigned on a first come / first serve basis
- Call rooms can be used in the day-time (if available) for quiet study space or independent case review/work
 - Rooms are cleaned mid-afternoon for evening/overnight call use
- Residents surveyed monthly. At start of rotation informally and at the end of rotation via online survey
 - Survey acts as an assessment to determine availability and areas for improvement
- 4 call room areas, each with multiple rooms within them across our two main hospital sites
