Southlake Family Medicine Residency Program

- The only residency program at Southlake
- 9 PGY1 per year
- 2-year horizontal program
- Rotate through various specialties while maintaining a mini practice within the FMTU



FMTU Space

- 6 dedicated resident rooms outfitted with AV observation equipment
- Resident work room equipped with computers, phones, mailboxes and personal items lockers available in hallway
- Kitchen with fridge and other supplies
- Shared procedure room and a gynecology room

Hospital Space



- Designated FM resident call room
- Staff Wifi:
 - Login and password same as hospital IT system login and password.
 - S-BYOD.
- Multi faith prayer room:
 - Second Floor by Central Elevators.
- Lactation Room:
 - Accommodations when requested to locate an appropriate location/room.

Hospital Space cont'd

- Hospital Lockers/Change Rooms:
 - OR change-room on the 2nd floor by the ORs (no lockers but place to leave belongings/shoes) – locked to employees only.
 - OB-Gyn: designated locker room with 1-2 lockers for residents/medical students, between the Birthing Unit the Central elevators in a room labelled “Storage” (bring your own lock). *If you are on call, you are to use the call room to store belongings to not take up space on floor*
 - Designated bank of lockers on the 1st floor in the hallway by the Medical Staff Office – locks on lockers, combinations with Program Admin.

- Simulation Room
 - ACLS, PALS, other training experience (manikins)
