Transfer Guidelines

- Reviewed and updated to ensure processes and language are aligned with the national (AFMC) policy
- Provided additional details to improve transparency and clarity, while respecting the confidential nature of the transfer process
- Indicated that priority will be given to first-time transfer requests and to residents
 requesting a transfer prior to the final year of training in their home program to align
 with Family Medicine where transfer requests will only be considered at the PGY1
 level (except for those considering entry to Public Health and Preventive Medicine)
- Included information specific to Sponsored Residents
- Transfer section on PGME website being updated
- Information sessions planned for December and January

- COI guide and selection committee member attestation form updated based on feedback received since the September PGMEAC meeting
- Included an emerging COI regarding participation in the selection process of more than one institutions
- Alignment of policies across TFoM
