### Assessment Completion Preliminary Analysis

July 8 - Sept 10 2019, incl

- 5659 EPA assessments completed to date
- ▶ 44% "Complete Now"
- # of assessments completed via email ("Confirm and Complete" or "Email Blank Form") risen from last year (45% vs 32% in 2018-19\*)
- Majority (70%) completed in <24 hours</p>
- Still high proportion (22%) of incomplete / non-submitted assessments (despite new "Preview" function in Elentra)
- More triggered by faculty (11% vs 2.5% in 2018-19\*)

\*Note: more fulsome analysis and comparison between academic years is underway

### 2018-19 Program Feedback Survey Preliminary Analysis

- Online survey of CBD-launched Program Directors (PD), Program Administrators (PA) and CBME Leads
- Questions on CBD implementation planning process (incl curriculum & assessment development and faculty development); Elentra & Tableau usability, training and resources; and PGME support
- ▶ N = 19 → roughly  $\frac{1}{2}$  PDs,  $\frac{1}{2}$  PAs
- Overall satisfied with PGME support
- Some trends in suggestions for improvement
  - Continued Elentra & Tableau development (usability, data visualization, reporting)
  - Stratify CBD Mini-Conferences by implementation stage (i.e. newly launching / piloting vs. continued launch)
  - Less repetition in curriculum & assessment CBD planning activities
