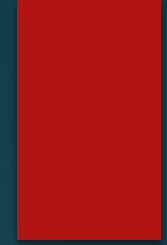

Assessment Tool Development

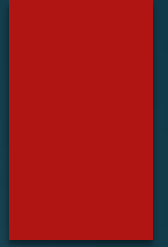
Planning underway for 2020-21

- ▶ Improving process for programs and reducing room for error
 - ▶ Streamlining old assessment tool templates
 - ▶ Plans for CBD PGME team to pre-fill templates with Milestone and Contextual Variables per Specialties' Royal College documents
- ▶ Developing our internal work plan and schedule to prepare for tool development (in collaboration w/ programs) and tool building in Elentra
- ▶ Setting deadlines and expectations for programs wanting to pilot
