# Context for 2020-21

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- No major government policy changes affecting quotas so far
- Reduction of **25 PGY1 residency** cuts in Ontario for **CMGs** (instituted in 2016) are continuing for 2020 – U of T share is **9**.
- No changes to **IMG** positions – 200 PGY1 provincially and 70 at U of T
- Government shared its data on physician health workforce needs – limited distribution. Identified needs in: **Diagnostic Radiology, Dermatology, Ophthalmology** and **Psychiatry**.
- Decreased demand for: **Emergency Medicine, most Surgical Specialties, Internal Medicine, Anatomical Pathology, PMR and Radiation Oncology, Neurology and Pediatrics**
- U of T and NOSM collaborating on a Northern Obs/Gyn program with 1 position for 2020 – pending confirmation by MOHLTC
- DFCM offering 2-3 positions for DND sponsored trainees in 2020

# PGY1 Positions

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- Quota Allocations survey of all PDs conducted in Spring 2019 to assess requests and identify current information on supply and demand.
- QA Subcommittee met July 2<sup>nd</sup> to review requests and consider allocation scenarios:
  - CMGs – Anesthesia, Dermatology, Obs/Gyn, Internal Medicine, Anatomical Pathology and Pediatrics requested increases
  - IMGs – Vascular Surgery and Internal Medicine requested increases.
- Proposed 2020 quotas compared to 2019:
  - **CMG increases:** Anatomical Pathology, Hematological Pathology
  - **CMG decreases:** FM, Emergency Medicine, Urology, and continued decreases in Dermatology, Ortho, Gen Surg and Internal Medicine
  - **IMGs:** No change other than distribution of Lab Med positions (Ana Path and Hem Path)
