Case Logs

PGME has embarked on an enhancement to the Case Log function, which currently exists in POWER.
 The enhancements will allow for ease of use, building on existing case logs (rather than having to enter new ones for each procedure), integration with ITERs and a mobile application. The enhanced case log feature should be available by Spring/Summer 2013.

POWER Rotation and Scheduling Enhancements

 POWER is being enhanced to better reflect the increase in longitudinal and multi-site rotations and to allow for scheduling and evaluation of these types of rotations. It will also feature an enhanced schedule function for learners, program administrators and hospital administrators to track activity by site, rotation service and learner.
