On-Line Privacy Module for UGME and PGME Learners

Background:

An on-line privacy module is currently in use in UGME. The content of the module was created by the Toronto Central LHIN Privacy Officers Working Group and the Ad Hoc Privacy Officers Working Group of the TAHSN Research Ethics Committee.

The module standardizes how learners demonstrate their knowledge of Personal Health Information (PHI) -- what it is, and how to protect that information. The module consists of a PHI tutorial with reference to topical news items, legislation, clinical scenarios, and ends with a 5-question quiz. The link to the module is

At present, UGME learners are required to complete the module, print a "successful completion" certificate which is submitted to the Academy and recorded in MedSIS.

The T-IME Learner Experience Working Group requests that the privacy module be embedded in both MedSIS and POWER. Learners will then be able to log on to their record, complete the module, and have their successful completion automatically updated in the learner record. In the event a learner does not complete the module, they will receive alert messages until they do so. Please see the screen shots below.


The advantages for learners and hospital medical education offices are that the learner will be required to demonstrate his/her PHI and privacy knowledge only once, instead of re-testing at each rotation site.

Issues to be explored before requesting formal approval to proceed with this development include clarification of module ownership, and responsibility for revision (coding) and maintenance, and guidelines regarding hospitals which may want to continue their current privacy assurance programs. Once these issues are addressed, PGME and UGME will work with Knowledge4You to implement the module.

Module Completion Screen




