Quota Allocations - Background

- In mid cycle of PGY Expansion
- Government focus on FM Expansion with considerable advocacy around infrastructure to support growth
- Proportionate share of U of T Royal College PG growth is small. Ongoing advocacy to increase the number of RC expansion positions (currently 27)
- Focus of expansion on Scarborough, Mississauga and Barrie/Orillia and Midland
- Developing more PG presence at these sites and new streams of training
- Increase in subspecialty programs moving to CaRMS
- Purpose of today's presentation is approval of quota proposals

Subspecialty Quota Planning - Considerations

- FM – PGY3 Expansion and timing
- DoM – Subspecialty expansion to flow through starting 2026-27
- Pediatrics – impact of 4 years of core training, timing of PSM and flow through of expansion starting 2027-28. Business case submitted to MOH.
- Psychiatry – business case for expansion plus Forensics and Geriatric Psychiatry in CaRMS as of Fall 2024 for 2025 start
- Surgery – Thoracic Surgery in CaRMS as of Fall 2024 for 2025 start. Colorectal Surgery in CaRMS as of Spring 2025 for a 2026 start. Impact of NRMP participation
- LMP – considering alternative pathway for Neuropathology
