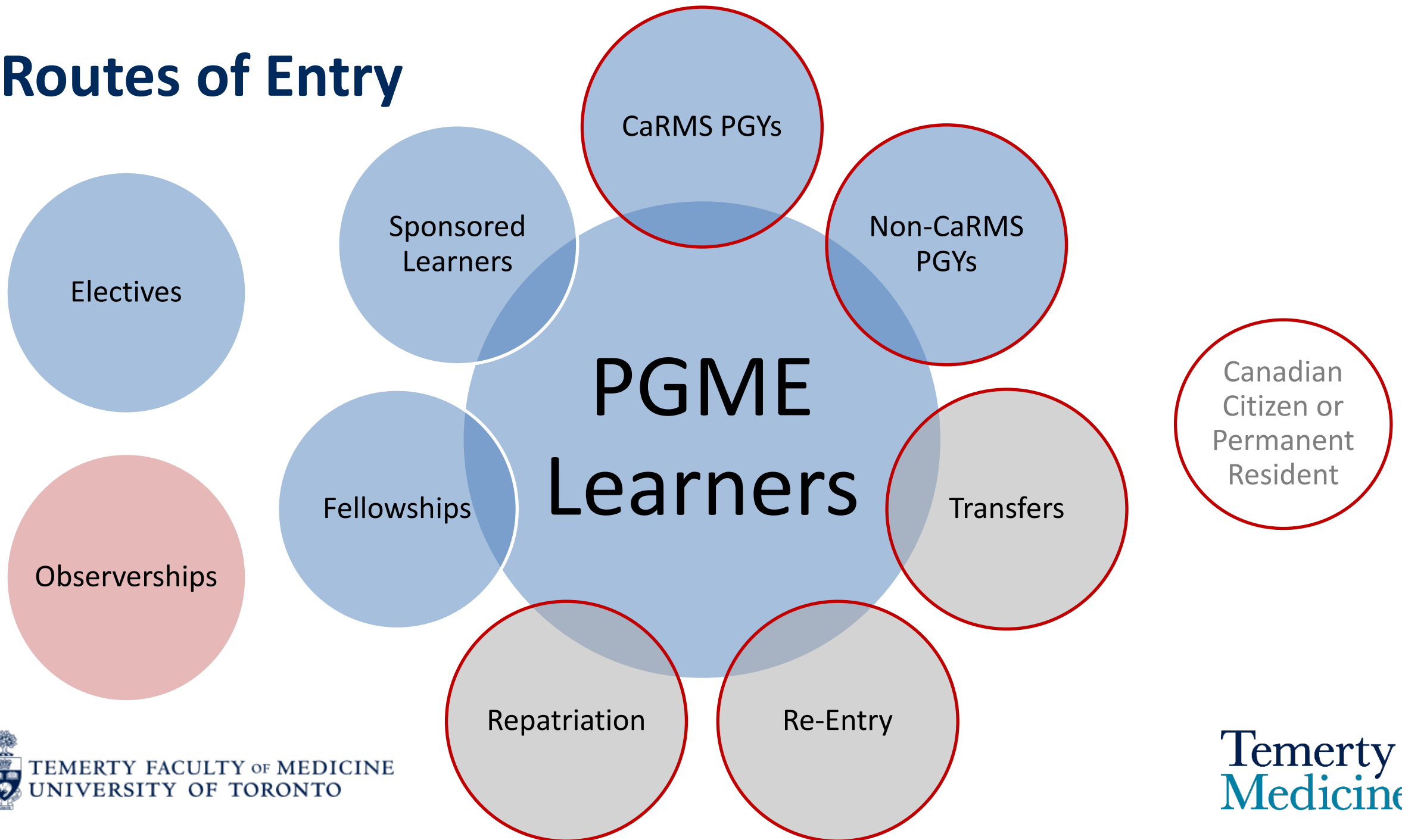

Electives

- Currently registered in postgraduate training
- Must be fully registered with PGME
- [Apply for Elective Training](#) of 6 months or less

- Managed directly by hospital medical education offices

- [R-1 Match](#)
 - IMG - [Touchstone](#) + 12-week [AVP](#) (PGY-1 only)
- [Medical Subspecialty Match \(MSM\)](#)
- [Pediatric Subspecialty Match \(PSM\)](#)
- [Family Medicine – Enhanced Skills \(FM/ES - Category 1\)](#)

Non-CaRMS

- Family Medicine – Enhanced Skills (Category 2)
- Subspecialty training: Lab Medicine, Medical Imaging, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Psychiatry, Surgery
- IMGs must complete [PEAP](#) (4-12 weeks)

ALL MOH-funded IMGs – ROS – regardless of route of entry





Transfers

- Managed centrally through pgme.transfers@utoronto.ca
- Core criteria: Capacity, Eligibility, Funding
- Internal Transfers – within UofT
 - UofT [Guidelines](#)
 - 83 requests / 18% or 15 successful
- External Transfers – outside of UofT
 - AFMC [Guidelines](#)
 - Incoming – 110 requests / 3.6% or 4 successful
 - Departing – 100 requests / 5% or 5 successful
- Sponsored Learners

Re-Entry

- Managed by the MOH
- Must be an independent practitioner for at least 12-months
- [Learners apply to the MOH for consideration](#)
- Successful applicants have an ROS commitment

Repatriation

- Managed by PGME at pgme.transfers@utoronto.ca
- Must meet the [MOH eligibility criteria](#)
- Letter of Assessment from the Royal College
- Successful applicants have an ROS commitment



Timelines

- **November** – Capacity commitment from programs
- **December** – Notice of timelines to programs
- **January** – Transfer survey is sent to all PGY1 and PGY 2 learners
 - Deadline is January 31 for **Internal Transfer** requests
- **February** – Program Review & Rankings for: Internal Transfers, Re-Entry, Repatriation, Sponsored – Concurrently with CaRMS
- **March** – PGME Review commences
 - National Deadline for **External Transfer** requests is March 31/23
- **April** – Match Day for 2nd iteration of CaRMS R-1 – April 27
 - Program Review for External Transfers (AFTER April 27/23)
