Waypoint – 500 Church St. Campus

- 315-bed specialty mental health hospital on scenic shores of Georgian Bay, in Penetanguishene. Serves clients through ON Central Region.
- Regional (civil) patients and provincial (forensic) patients – medium and high secure.
- Tertiary regional programs in SPMI, geriatrics, concurrent disorders and dual diagnosis, in addition to acute general adult
- Cutting edge neuro-modulation program with full service rTMS and ECT.





Waypoint – 500 Church St. Campus

- Multi-faith prayer space on site
- Bay Café open for lunch M-F, catered by community vendors
- Healthier choice vending machines and Starbucks coffee 24/7
- Library on site (business hours)
- Physician lounge (24/7 access)
- Gym facility, running trails, pickleball courts on grounds
- City bus stop on campus goes to downtown Penetanguishene

House 6

- Shared accommodation for learners and locums
- X2 min walk from hospital proper (also food drop off space)
- High speed Wi-Fi access
- Private lactation space
- 24/7 mobile security patrols grounds, escort available on request
- Parking is free for all learners – permit provided on first day.
- No call past 23:00 at Waypoint



Satellite Campuses – Health Hub

- Houses OATS (outpatient psychiatry) and Family, Child & Youth Mental Health Programs. Chigamik FHT is here too.
- X10 min drive form Church St. campus, in downtown Midland
- Coffee and snacks for purchase on site or within walking distance. Kitchen on site.
- New facility with shared office space and private lactation space for learners.



Satellite Campuses – Jones Road Office

- Houses MTST (ACTT service)
- X15 min drive from Church St. Campus, x5 min from downtown Midland
- Private office and lactation space available
- Fast food available within walking distance, food drop off space and small kitchen on site



Satellite Campuses – SGS Office

- Most learners rotating through Specialized Geriatric Service (geriatric psychiatry outreach) will work virtually from House 6 or office at Church St. campus
- Office in North Barrie x 50 min drive from Church St. campus
- Private office and lactation space available
- Fast food nearby, fridge and food drop off space on site.





Onboarding for Learners

- Meditech EMR – virtual training modules with DocuSign to streamline processes
- E-learns around therapeutic interventions and safety training
- Microsoft Outlook e-mail and calendar system
- Zoom used for most meetings
- In-person or virtual IT support available during business hours
- Office space- House 6, library or locum offices available
