



## Information on Acute Respiratory Infection for Trainees Arriving/Returning from the Arabian Peninsula\*

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It is policy in Ontario hospitals that health care providers not come to work if they have symptoms that may be attributable to an acute infection that is transmissible from person-to-person, including symptoms that may be attributable to an acute respiratory infection:

- any of: fever, new or worse cough, shortness of breath, stuffy or runny nose, sore throat, sneezing, muscle aches

While the risk of MERS in healthcare workers arriving from countries of the Arabian peninsula is very low, it is important that all countries take a precautionary approach to this serious virus. Thus, we are grateful for your collaboration in monitoring yourself for symptoms compatible with an acute respiratory infection, and reporting such symptoms should they occur.

If you develop symptoms of an acute respiratory infection within 14 days of arriving in Canada

OR

If you develop symptoms of an acute respiratory infection after having been in contact with a person who developed symptoms of an acute respiratory infection within 14 days of arriving in Canada from the Arabian peninsula

- stay home
- notify one of the following: program director, senior resident, attending staff physician, preceptor, or academy director that you are unwell and staying home
- inform the Occupational Health or Infection Control department in your hospital/clinical environment (as appropriate)

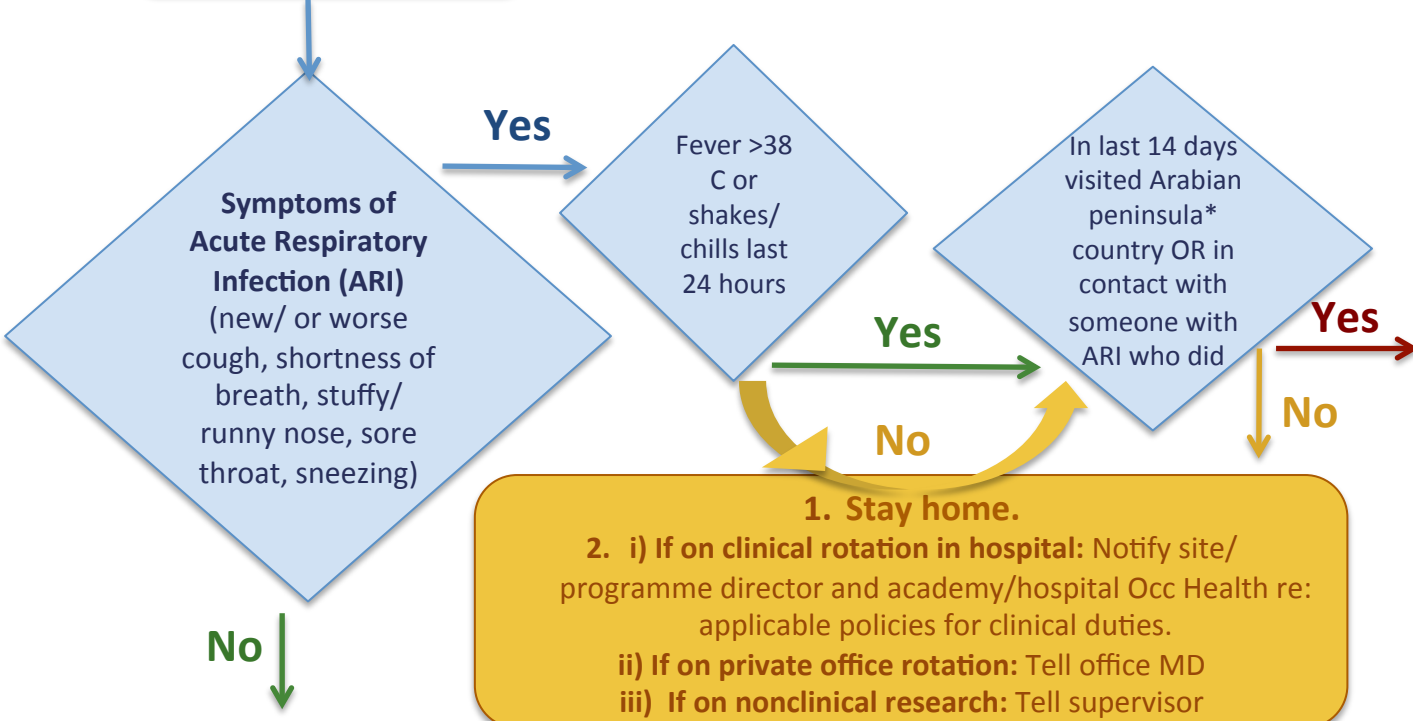
