



Top reasons for disability claims



- Psychiatric claims make up 61% of all claims in the 20-30 age band.
 Drops to 15% for the 30-40 band.
- Pregnancy related claims take up 41% of all claims in the 30-40 band; psychiatric drops to second at 15% - tied with injuries.
- Cancer represents only 5% of claims in the 30-40 age band.
