


- Internal reviews for 4 AFC programs with follow-up by ER (newly accredited and off-cycle)
- Review of action plan and draft APORs for 1 AFC program with follow-up by APOR

IRC Activity

- 18 programs reviewed
- 8 action plans reviewed

Follow-up Requested

- 6 resubmit of Action Plan with changes made

Institutional Review

- 76 Residency programs, 3 Areas of Focused Competence programs included in the survey

- Over 60 administrative personnel

Institutional Review

- Action Plan Outcomes Report due November 2023
- 3 Areas For Improvement (AFI) for APOR

Requirement 2.2.2: There are adequate resources and support to allow residency programs to meet accreditation standards.

Requirement 4.1.4: Residency education occurs in a positive learning environment that promotes resident wellness.

Requirement 6.1.1: There is a process of systematic teacher assessment and feedback.
