Guest Speakers

Post Accreditation PA Survey (@ 1pm) - L. Murgaski

- 3 surveys were sent out, one to the PDs, one to the Pas, and one to those who participated in the Institutional Review
- Lots of positive feedback received through the survey
- Laura highlighted some comments that were interesting
- Time spent on the AQ varied widely between 20 to 250 hours, with an average of 57 hours
- Support from the PGME was well received
- Redacting documents was tedious but wouldn't have been necessary if we didn't have COVID
- Some PAs felt pressured to answer the reviewers questions a certain way, and some felt they couldn't be honest as it would affect the overall outcome of the review for their program
- One comment about abuse that a PA was experiencing was a great cause for concern and the committee felt further discussions need to be happen about it.
- Most of the committee members felt strongly that a peer support group/program should be created, where it is considered a safe space to talk about this and any other issues that a

colleague may be facing

- Also, need to be equipped with the right tools to help or deal with sensitive issues like abuse, etc.
- Will need to look into more depth on how to create the safe space and what the goal is for the support program

Elentra - Rotation Scheduler Demo (@ 1:30pm) - C. Abrahams & C. Rios

- A new rotation scheduler is being launched in Elentra and it's currently being tested with OBGYN
- Will eventually roll it out to the other departments/programs over the next 3 years
- We will also be able to add in teachers/supervisors without having to go through the current process
- The new features added to Elentra are a welcome addition
- The stipend feature in POWER will not be migrated over to Elentra yet
