

PG Expansion Update

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Background

- PGME expansion plans, approved by government, are for 45 new PGY1 positions to be added over four years, with 15 beginning in 2023-24

	July 2023	July 2024	July 2025	July 2026
Cumulative Expansion PGY1 Positions	15	26	39	45

- For 2023 all positions allocated to CMGs with expectation of blended second iteration of CaRMS
- Government objective is for 60% of positions in FM with an overall CMG:IMG split of 80:20
- Enhanced expansion funding for positions still under consideration by government

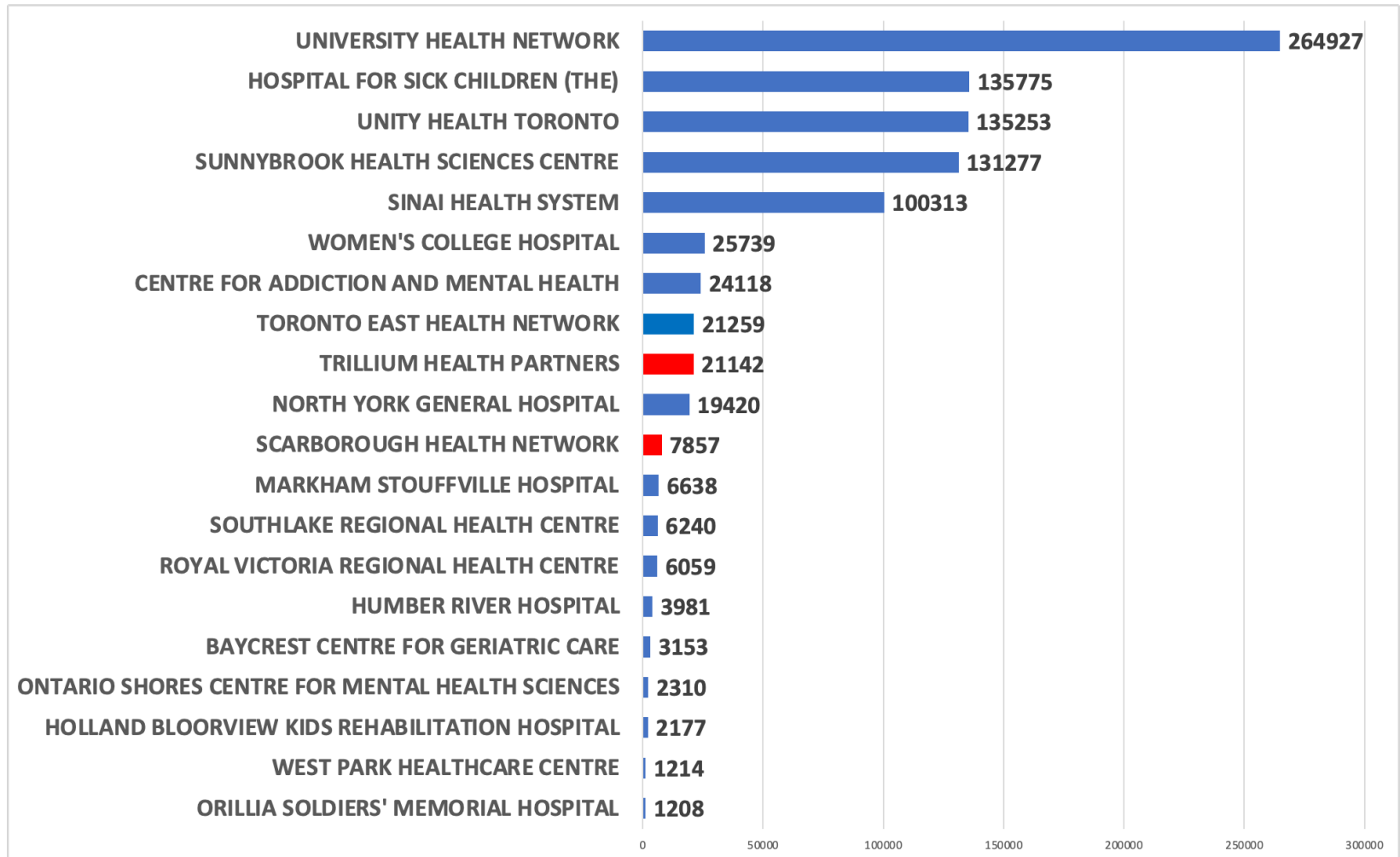


Planning for Expansion

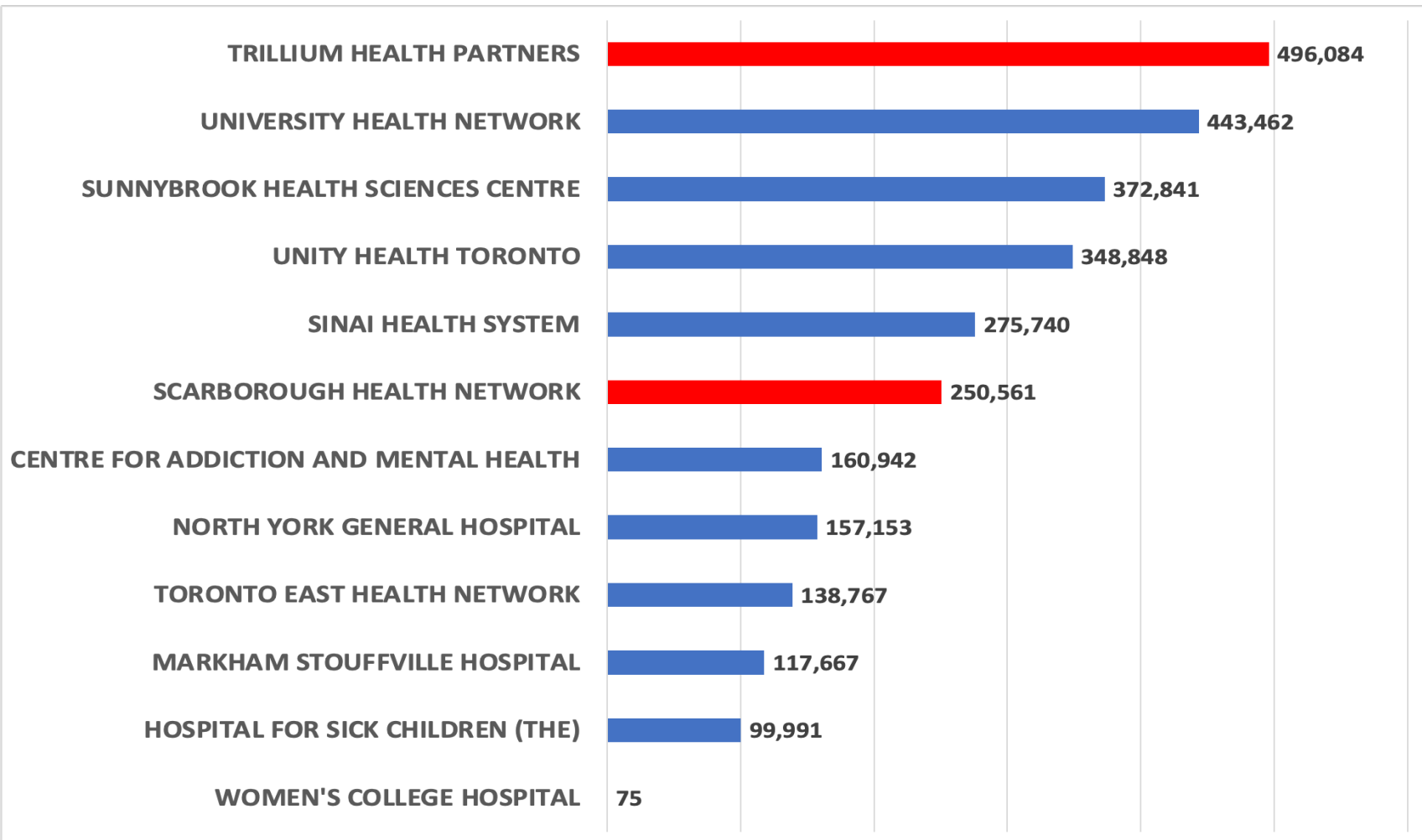
- Consistent with recent announcements and commitments by the Dean and government, focus of expansion will be on **Trillium Health Partners** and **Scarborough Health Network**
- Family Medicine also expanding at Humber River Hospital.
- THP-PG Working Group has been established co-chaired by A. Freeland and M. Giuliani to plan for expansion
- Several working groups underway to support SHN expansion with PG focus beginning in new year.



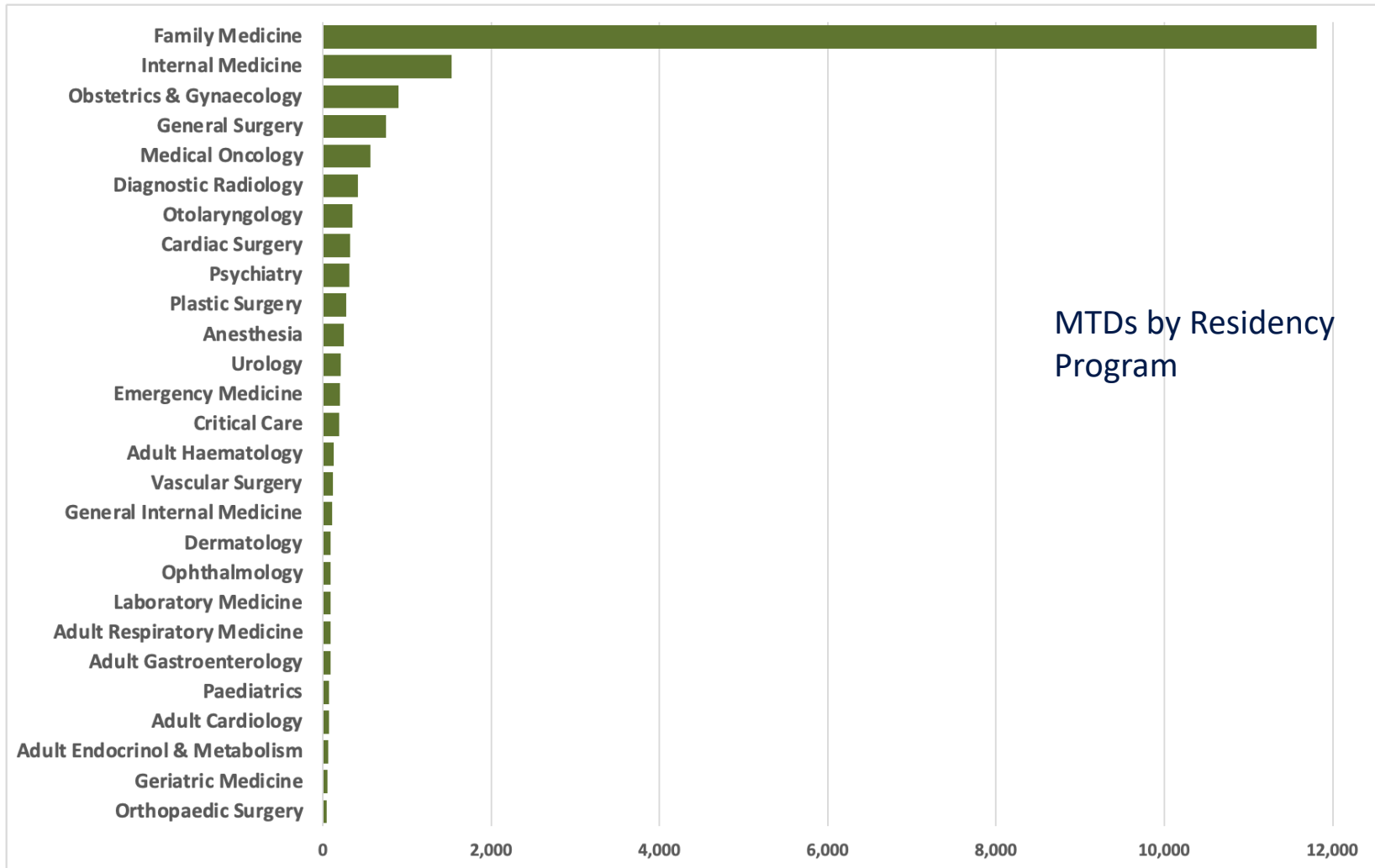
Current Distribution of PG Activity – 2020-21 MTDs

Approach

- Goal is to enable and grow necessary resources, infrastructure and processes for THP and SHN to become “base sites” for selected programs
- Will require more than new specialty expansion positions to achieve dedicated capacity at both sites
- Opportunity for a rebalancing of learning environments and reduced reliance on residents for service



Proposed Next Steps

- PGME will be reaching out to individual Programs and Departments to explore opportunities for focused presence of PG learners at THP
- Will include a “readiness assessment” for phased in growth of residents on core rotations.
- Development of multi-year plans to add/expand learners in Mississauga
- Consider:
 - Site roles (PG Lead, site director, admin staff etc.)
 - Faculty and Preceptors (appointments, FacDev, mentors)
 - Space requirements
 - Accreditation requirements (Minimum and Core Requirements as per RC, LE, wellness, assessment and evaluation etc.)
 - Learner Safety
 - Financial Resources
