Expansion of Medical Learners at TFOM


- To date the government of Ontario has announced a provincial expansion of 281 new medical student intake positions (27% increase) and 449 new PGY1 positions (37% increase) by 2027/28
- TFOM's share of this provincial expansion is 44 new MD positions (17%) and 67 new PGY1 positions (16%)
- Expansion includes the creation of new medical school at TMU, and at TFOM creation of new campus – Scarborough Academy of Medicine and Integrated Health (SAMIH)
- New leadership to support expansion includes Dr. Molly Zirkle, Director, SAMIH expansion. Dr Samir Grover recently announced as VP Education at SHN starting Dec 2, 2023. Dr. Caroline Thompson announced as Interim VP Education.

Quota Allocation Process

- Survey of all Programs Spring 2023
- 3 meetings of Quota Allocations Subcommittee to review capacity, proposals and assumptions
- Reviewed principles of allocations including focus on growth at THP and SHN
- Discussions with PG leadership at Department level and Program level
- Ongoing discussions with MOH regarding resources to support expansion via COFM and TFOM

Other Subspecialties

- Pediatrics => MOH funded envelope of up to 21 for 14 subspecialties plus Pediatric Critical Care (3). Fall 2023 CaRMS match underway with expectation of fewer applicants. Another match will occur in Spring 2024 in light of transition to 4-year Core Pediatrics. (Business case to support expansion submitted to MOH)
- Surgery => MOH funded envelope of 16 (Surg. Onc, Pediatric Surgery, Thoracic Surgery, Colorectal Surg)
- Diagnostic Radiology => MOH funded envelope of 12 (Nuc Med, Neuroradiology, Pediatric Radiology, Interventional Radiology)
- Obs/Gyn => MOH funded envelope of 12 (GREI, Mat Fetal Med, Gyne Onc)
- Psychiatry => MOH funded envelope of 12 (Geriatric Psych, Child and Adolescent, Forensic) (Business case to support expansion submitted to MOH)
- Forensic Pathology = 2



Next Steps

- 2024 Quota Allocations requires approval by PGMEAC
- Meeting with MOH and TFOM to discuss funding for current allocation plus expansion – later today.
- PGME continuing to work with programs/departments to build capacity in Scarborough Health Network and Trillium Health Partners (Mississauga) with potential development of dedicated streams.
- Proposals under development via COFM to mitigate challenge of PGY1 CaRMS match as a result of PGY growth in advance of expanded CMG graduates.
