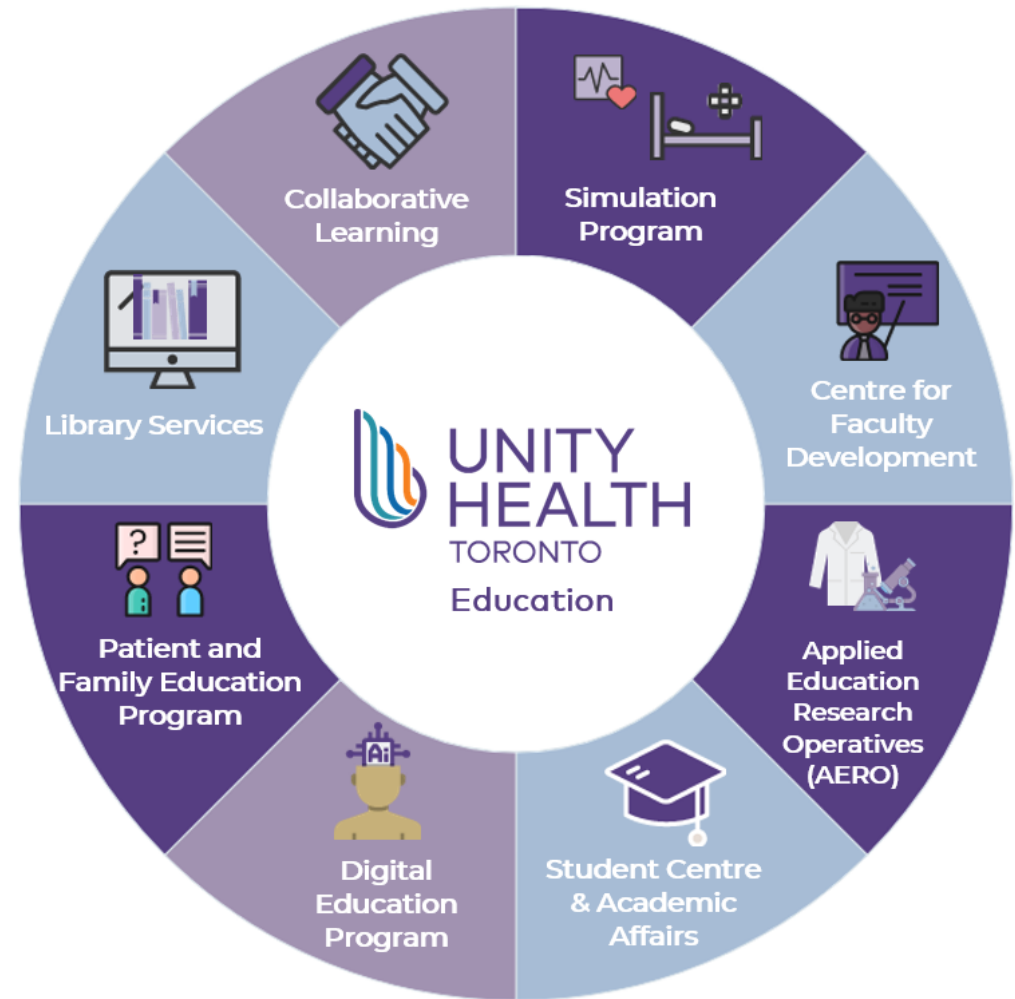

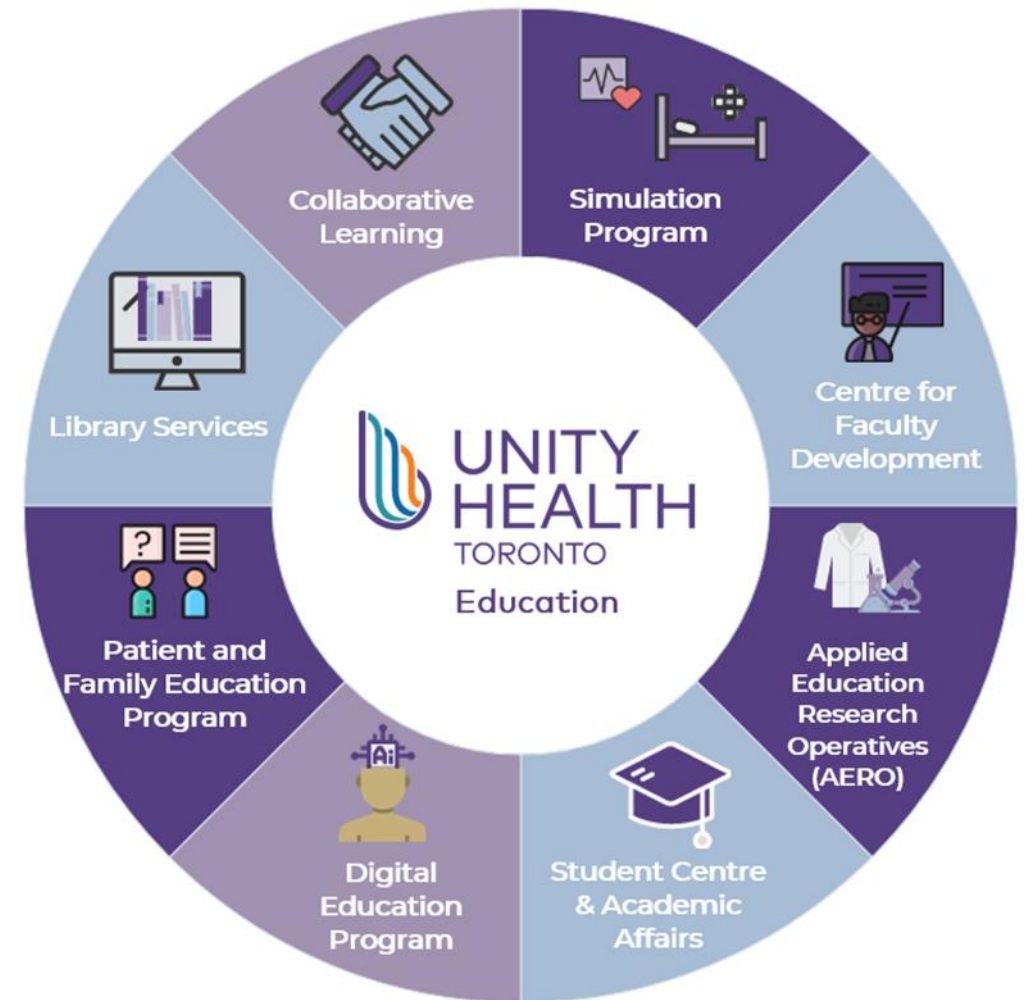
- Since 2022: New/updated call room suites @ SJHC & SMH
